Brothers,

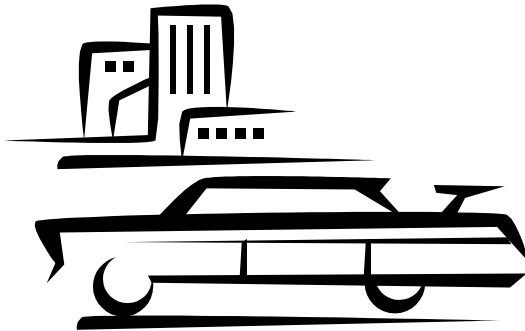
