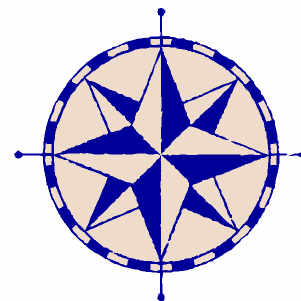
Brothers,

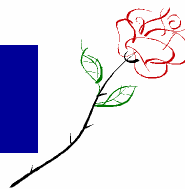
