COOKIE DOUGH FUNDRAISER

Squires,

We have the opportunity to make a generous profit for our circle. It all depends on us. It is very easy and little physical work is involved. We will be selling frozen cookie dough and if we do it right, people will look forward to buying from us again.

SAFETY FIRST – Sell only to people you and family know

Each of you will receive an order form. We need to sell an item minimum of 150. We have 24 squire members and 5 counselors. If we sell 10 each, that's 290 orders. The items sell for \$13 each and we get \$4.50 for each item we sell. That is \$1305 we can make. We will use this money to adopt our seminarian and take a trip to Hot Springs.

At the next meeting each squire will receive an order form. As soon as you receive your form, you can begin taking orders. I will have dates and times on when we need to orders turned in and when we will receive our orders at the next meeting.
